

THE CURRAGH

The Curragh, one of the world's most iconic racecourses offers magnificent facilities on a par with the best in the world. The centrepiece of the racecourse is the spectacular multi-purpose grandstand which incorporates five-star facilities on four levels and superb viewing of the racecourse. Featuring a parade ring and saddling boxes, which ensures that more patrons can share in the excitement and build up to the racing, while the historic Queen's Rooms celebrates the heritage of the racecourse and is used on race days to bring winning owners for celebratory refreshments.

THE CURRAGH'S COURS

A right-handed horseshoe-shaped course over two miles, with an adjoining chute feeding into the home straight which stages races of up to a mile. It has a three furlong run-in with an uphill finish and is regarded as one of the best and fairest racecourses in the world.



TRAINING GROUNDS

Comprising of approximately 1,500 acres, the Curragh training grounds include 80 miles of grass gallops. Used daily by approximately 900 horses in the care of 55 horse trainers. The training grounds are owned and managed by the Curragh and have been used by international stars such as Harzand and Sea The Stars. The Curragh training grounds are located at the Curragh Racecourse, 40 minutes from Leopardstown Racecourse and Dublin airport. TRAVEL GUIDE

Travelling to Ireland is convenient with an increasing number of air and ferry routes to the island now available. The island of Ireland has five main ferry ports - Belfast, Dublin, Dun Laoghaire, Larne and Rosslare, and seven main airports - Belfast, Cork, Dublin, Kerry, Knock, Shannon and Waterford.
