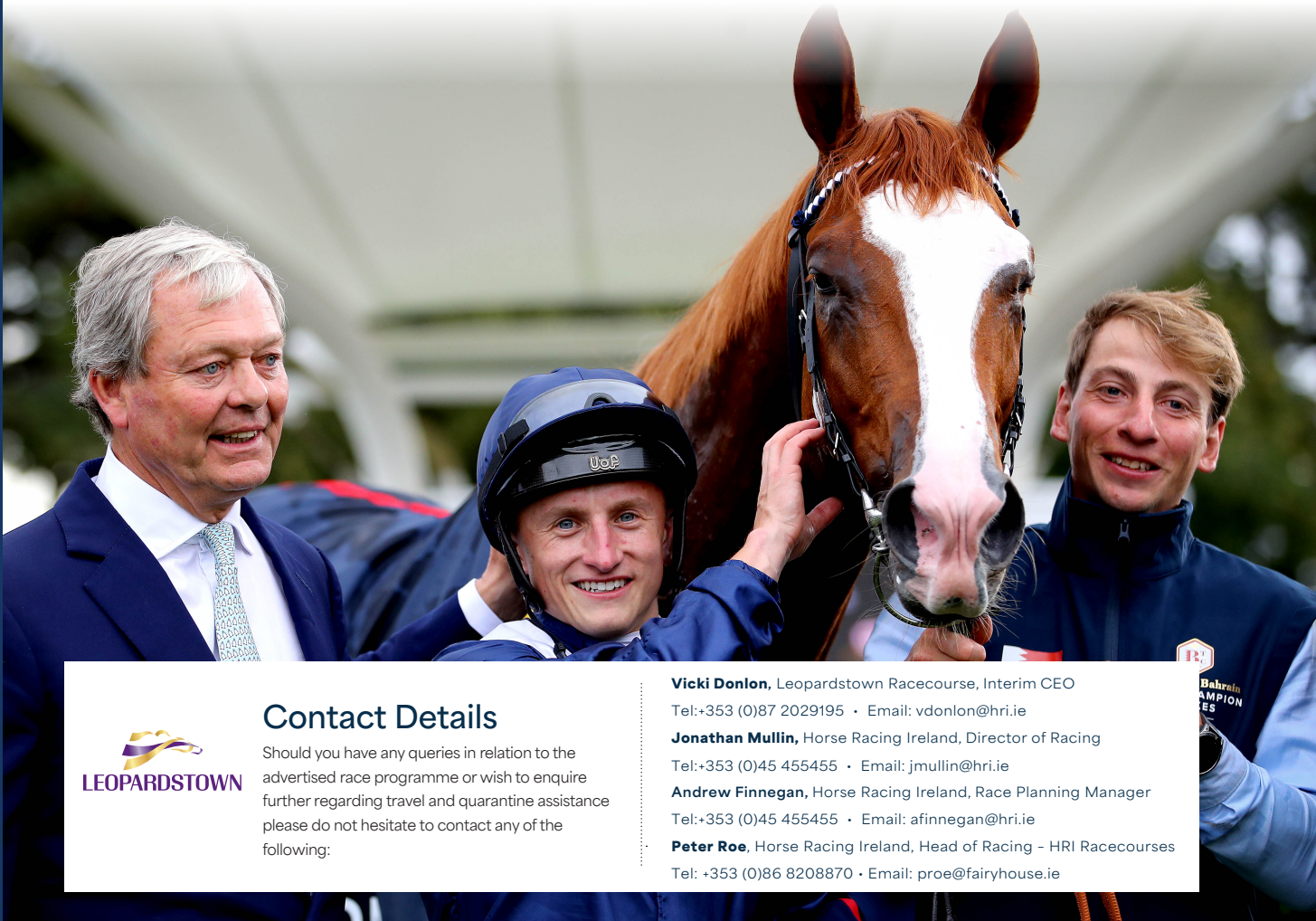

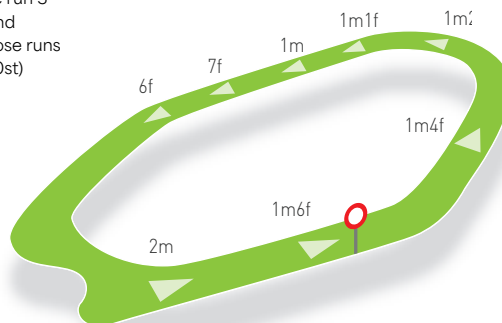

Day Two at the Curragh includes four Group 1 races, highlighted by the Comer Group International Irish St Leger, the final Irish Classic of the season, and the Bar One Racing Flying Five Stakes, together with The Goffs Vincent O'Brien National Stakes and the Moyglare Stud Stakes, two of the best juvenile races of the year which are likely to determine the champion two-year-olds in Europe once again.

## THE CURRAGH

The Curragh, one of the world's most iconic racecourses offers magnificent facilities on a par with the best in the world. The centrepiece of the racecourse is the spectacular multi-purpose grandstand which incorporates five-star facilities on four levels and superb viewing of the racecourse. Featuring a parade ring and saddling boxes, which ensures that more patrons can share in the excitement and build up to the racing.

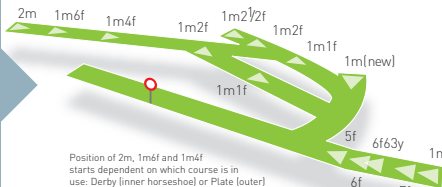


## TRAINING GROUNDS

Comprising of approximately 1,500 acres, the Curragh training grounds include 80 miles of grass gallops. Used daily by approximately 900 horses in the care of 55 horse trainers. The training grounds are owned and managed by the Curragh and have been used by international stars such as Harzand and Sea The Stars. The Curragh training grounds are located at the Curragh Racecourse, 40 minutes from Leopardstown Racecourse and Dublin airport. ## THE CURRAGH'S COURSE

A right-handed horseshoe-shaped course over two miles, with an adjoining chute feeding into the home straight which stages races of up to a mile. It has a three furlong run-in with an uphill finish and is regarded as one of the best and fairest racecourses in the world.

# STABLING & ACCOMMODATION

**Curragh:** Stabling for runners at The Curragh will be available at the racecourse to include access to the world famous Curragh Training Grounds.

**Leopardstown:** Leopardstown Racecourse have modern stabling available at the Racecourse which is in South Dublin, stabling outside the racecourse can be arranged also. Accommodation for racing staff is provided in nearby locations.

Accommodation and transportation for racing staff will be provided courtesy of the relevant racecourse.
